





So, as you can see, Diwali is a fabulous holiday.



Ashtavakra Gita

India is a land of great sages, Rishis and Munis. Ashtavakra (अध्यक्क), one of the holy sages, was a great expositor of the Self, freedom from bondage, and transcendence to the supreme state of eternal bliss. The Ashtavakra Gita embodies his teachings in the form of a dialogue between the sage Ashtavakra and King Janaka. Not much historical is known about the life of Ashtavakra, however, several stories can be found in Mahabharata. One must know some of the interesting stories about his birth and contact with King Janaka to appreciate the exposition in Ashtavakra Gita.

Ashtavakra was the son of sage Kahor and Sujata. Kahor was a great scholar of Vedas. Ashtavakra learned Vedas from his father while still in the womb of his mother. One day, Kahor was teaching his disciples and made mistakes while reciting a Vedic mantra. "Father your recitation is wrong." Ashtavakra exclaimed from the womb. Kahor was angry and cursed his son, you will be born with eight deformities in your body. True to the curse, the son was born with eight crooked parts (deformities) in his body and thus was named Ashtavakra.

Kahor went to King Janaka's court to get some monetary help but was defeated in debate by the court Vedic scholar Vandin, the son of King Varuna. Kahor was made to go into sea to take part in a sacrifice performed by King Varuna. As the time passed, Ashtavakra grew to twelve years of age, his mother sent him to King Janaka's court to bring his father back. Ashtavakra easily defeated Vandin in the debate and secured release of his father and many other Vedic scholars who were defeated in debate by Vandin and confined to sea.

King Janaka was impressed by the spiritual prowess of Ashtavakra and sought to become his disciple. It must be noted that King Janaka was not only the most powerful king but also a highly spiritually advanced person of his time. Ashtavakra Gita is a compilation of Ashtavakra's teachings as a dialogue between the sage Ashtavakra and King Janaka.

Ashtavakra follows a very simple, intuitive, uncompromising, and direct approach to teach the profound truths of Upanishads. One can feel the magic of the transcendental from his answer to the very first question of King Janaka. Ashtavakra Gita has 20 chapters and a total of 298 slokas. The text starts with a question from King Janaka in first sloka:

कथं ज्ञानमवाप्नोति कथं मुक्तिर्भविष्यति । वैराग्यं च कथं प्राप्तं एतदु बृहि मम प्रभो ॥ १-१॥

O my Prabhu, tell me how knowledge of Truth can be acquired, tell me how liberation can be achieved, also tell me how renunciation is realized (in life). Ashtavakra replies,

मुक्तिं इच्छिसि चेत्तात विषयान् विषवत्त्यज । क्षमार्जवद्यातोषसत्यं पीयूषवदु भज ॥ १-२॥

If you want liberation, O' my child, give up the objects of senses (विषयान) like poison (विष). Seek, cultivate forgiveness, sincerity, kindness, contentment, and truth like the nectar (अमिन).

First, it is interesting and instructive to see from the first two Slokas that how King Janaka addresses Ashtavakra, a twelve-year boy with deformed body, as "my Lord" (PD), and how Ashtavakra calls King Janaka as "my child." This is because a Guru and disciple relationship has been established and agreed to between Ashtavakra and King Janaka. We must understand that the Guru is held in the highest esteem in our culture from the ancient times. The physical form, and materialistic status of

the two in a Guru-disciple relationship is of no significance. The Guru is The Guru and must be held in highest esteem. Second, Ashtavakra propagates a simple path to knowledge of Brahman, liberation, and renunciation, that is, cultivation of virtues like forgiveness, sincerity, kindness, contentment, and Truth (Truthfulness). The same path to enlightenment is also propagated by Guru Nanak,

सचु वरत् संतोखु तीरथु गिआनु धिआनु इसनानु ॥ दिइआ देवता खिमा जपमाली ते माणस परधान ॥

Those who make Truth (Truthfulness) their solemn vow, contentment their sacred place of pilgrimage, spiritual knowledge and meditation their cleansing bath, as well as kindness their deity to worship and forgiveness their chanting beads, those people are spiritually most exalted. In fact, one cannot follow a path of Dharma and attain liberation without acquiring these virtues. Guru Nanak says,

धौलु धरमु दिइआ का पूतु ॥

संतोखु थापि रखिआ जिनि सूति ॥ sggs Pg. 4

The mythological ox that holds earth in its place is, in fact, the Dharma, and Dharma is born of Kindness (दया), moreover, kindness is nurtured by contentment. Goswami Tulsi Das confirms, दया धर्म का मूल है।

Kindness is the root, the essential core of the Dharma. Again, Bhagat Kabir says,

गोधन गजे धन वाजिधन और रतनेधन खान । जब आए संतोष धन सब धन धूरि समान ॥

There are all kinds of wealth, like wealth of cows, wealth of elephants, wealth seized/acquired by force and wealth of mines full of gems, however, Bhagat Kabir says that all these wealth are like dirt when one acquires the wealth—the virtue of contentment. It seems to me that contentment is like the basic, the core virtue that nurtures other virtues.

Ashtavakra continues to answer other aspects of King Janaka's question in first sloka.

न पृथ्वी न जलं नाग्निर्न वायुर्धीर्न वा भवान् । एषां साक्षिणमात्मानं चिद्वपं विद्धि मुक्तये ॥ १-३॥

(O' my child, like phenomenal world, you are not made of five elements of creation.) You are not earth, not water, not fire, not air, and not even ether. If you wish to attain liberation, know yourself as the Self—Atman, witness of the empirical world, but different from all the phenomenal objects, the body, and the mind. Above all you are the Consciousness.

यदि देहं पृथक कृत्य चिति विश्राम्य तिष्टसि । अधुनैव सूखी शान्तो बन्धमुक्तो भविष्यसि ॥ १-४॥

If you detach yourself from the body, that is, do not identity yourself with the body, and calm your Chitta (चिना) that is rid your Chitta of all "agitations" (literally, remain at rest in Chitta), you will be spontaneously gain eternal bliss and peace, and attain liberation from the "perceived" bondage of Maya.

Ashtavakra instructs King Janaka to follow Self-Realization which is both the process and goal of recognizing that our true nature is the same as that of the Brahman — The Supreme Truth. Mundakya Upanishad clearly states: One who knows Brahman becomes Brahman, स यो ह ये तत्परमं ब्रह्म वेद ब्रह्मैय भवति ॥ MU. 3.2.9 Guru Nanak propagates similar philosophy, जिनी आतमु चीनिआ परमातमु सोई ॥ sggs Pg. 421 Those who know Atman become Paramatman. जन नानक बिनु आपा चीनै मिटै न भम की काई ॥ Pg. 684 that is, Guru Nanak says, without knowing the Self, the moss of delusion of duality cannot be eradicated.

Ashtavakra's Gita, even though not regarded as an Upanishad, yet comprises a systematic expounding of mystical and monistic Vedanta.

Thanks to those patrons/devotees who have completed the Hindu Temple Long-range planning (LRP) committee (Rakesh K. Singh, Chair; Malathi Balu, Co-chair; Natasha Keshwani; Jagdish Nijhawan, Srini Nedunoori) survey. In this survey, our goal was to identify specific areas of concern and develop goal-oriented plans to address specific deficiencies that impact our temple's long-term growth. We greatly appreciate your responses.

Based on the survey, we acknowledged the progress made in the religious services, which is reflected in the survey (Very Satisfied/satisfied). On the contrary, concerns persist in educational and spiritual services suggesting immediate and long-term investment.

The overall survey has given a better perspective regarding the current state of our temple services and the need for improvements.

Based on the feedback, the long-range planning committee is working on Hindu Temple Vision 2030, to be presented in Jan. 2022 to the board of trustees (BOT). Four subcommittees have been created to address specific areas chaired by a member of the LRP committee.


- ♦ Education services including Balvihar/Youth group (Chair-Natasha Keshwani)

Following approval from LRP, it will be forwarded to the BOT for their approval, followed by GBM approval (special meeting in March 2022).



Q1: Which aspect of our Hindu Temple mission is most important to you?



Q2: In what ways do you interact with our temple?




Q3: How satisfied are you with our temple's religious services?



Q4: How satisfied are you with our temple's spiritual program, including Vedantic Center?




Q5: How satisfied are you with our temple's education programs, including Balvihar and Youth classes?



Q6: How satisfied are you with the impact our temple has made since 2016?




Q7: When thinking about future generations, how important is it to you that we further our educational and spiritual mission?


